



Q: Why do I need to be a myHockey member to view detailed results?

A: Hockey Australia, in conjunction with State Associations, are utilising myHockey as a way of developing an online community and building stronger links with players and supporters. Your myHockey membership isn't just about viewing detailed results, it signals your support of the game and willingness to be a part of its growth. There's no hidden catches and it's totally free. Being a myHockey member is all about being connected and belonging to our great game.

Q: Who will benefit from me being a myHockey member?

A: You, your club, association and the game itself will benefit from your membership. Not only does your club and association get access to free websites and software to run their competitions, but (should you wish) they can now also include you in their online community, which means easier and quicker communications about the things you're interested in - hockey news, game details, club functions, newsletters etc.

Q: What if I don't want any communications?

A: As a myHockey member you can select what communications you receive, like email match reminders and club / team news, and what communications you don't want to receive. The choice is totally yours.

Q: Will I need to sign-in every time I want to view detailed results?

A: No, you will only need to put in your email address and password if you logged-out last time you visited. Most people choose to stay logged-on all the time, which will give you access to all detailed results right across HockeyNet whenever you want.

Q: Is there anything else I need to know about myHockey?

A: Three really important things to note; **1)** your membership details will never be sold to a third party, **2)** joining myHockey is free and only takes approximately 30 seconds, and **3)** When you join myHockey you will also receive for free your very own myHockey website page, which has loads of features and allows you to connect with other hockey players and supporters.
